Matthew 5:5

The first two beatitudes are centered on self.

Blessed are the poor in spirit - "What must \_\_\_\_\_ empty from my life that is sin"?

Blessed are those who mourn – What sin must I \_\_\_\_\_ over?

Vs 5 a shift from self to \_\_\_\_\_.

What is my role in the lives of others that will point them to God?

Words have \_\_\_\_\_.
